

Plums, Cherries, Apricots & Nectarines

Fair Dinkum Fertilizers Liquid Seaweed GOLD should be applied at bud burst, and then three or four applications at 3-4 week intervals.

Application rates for each should be 3-5 l/ha for small to moderate size trees increasing up to 6-7 l/ha for larger trees.

Fair Dinkum Fertilizers Liquis Seaweed MATE or PREMIUM can be used on the first two sprays. Only use GOLD Liquid Seaweed on the final spray.

To obtain some degree of frost protection Fair Dinkum Fertilizers FROST GUARD can be used at 2-3 l/ha every 10-12 days during the frost danger period. Do not use MATE or PREMIUM in the frost danger period.

An application before bud burst will increase fruit set. An application of GOLD 1-2 weeks before harvest will also improve keeping quality.

Stone fruit growers often apply seaweed granules in late Autumn / Winter which breaks down to supply a range of trace elements, plant growth hormones and potassium. These should be applied at a rate of 70-150kg/ha. Some benefits that have been observed are as follows:

Improved frost tolerance
Improved fruit colour
Increased yields
Increased sugar content (BRIX Reading)
Increased resistance to fungal and disease attack
Increased shelf life.
